Responsibilities and Safety Practices

- You must not attend the Shed under the influence of alcohol or drugs that impair your safety.
- Alcohol may only be consumed at the Shed during official social events.
- The Shed is a non-smoking environment.
- You know the location of the emergency evacuation muster point.
- You know the location of the emergency stop buttons in the wood and metal shops.
- Suitable work shoes must be worn at all times. Open-toed footwear is not allowed.
- Jewellery, ties, loose clothing, or other items that could become caught in machinery are not to be worn.
- Long hair is to be tied back.
- You may attend the Shed from 9am-3pm Monday to Friday, unless advised otherwise.
- **Only use powered machinery/ tools in the workshops when another member is present.**
- When working on personal projects, you are to supply your own material whenever possible.
- When practicable, you should take your personal project home at the end of each day.
- Only one person may use any machine at a time, unless tailing-out.
- If a machine you wish to use is currently being used by someone else, patiently wait your turn.
- Make yourself available to help others with heavy lifting, if you are physically able.
- You should stop work during Shed breaks to encourage group socialisation.
- Safety is the number one priority. Focus on both yours and that of others.
- **Do not operate machinery until you are deemed proficient.**
- You are encouraged to learn how to use unfamiliar machinery, to widen your skill base.
- Safety glasses or a face shield must be worn when operating machinery, and ear muffs if noisy.
- Tools and equipment must be returned to their storage location after use.
- Two names must be used on a tag when tagging out. Either person can remove the tag.
- The committee has the final word on any decisions.

The Responsibilities and Safety Practices detailed above are for both your own protection and that of others around you. The Shed has a duty of care to its members and we need to ensure you are covered in case of injury or a claim under our liability insurance policy.

The points listed above will be explained to you by a committee member. If you do not understand something, please ask for clarification. There is no such thing as a stupid question.
