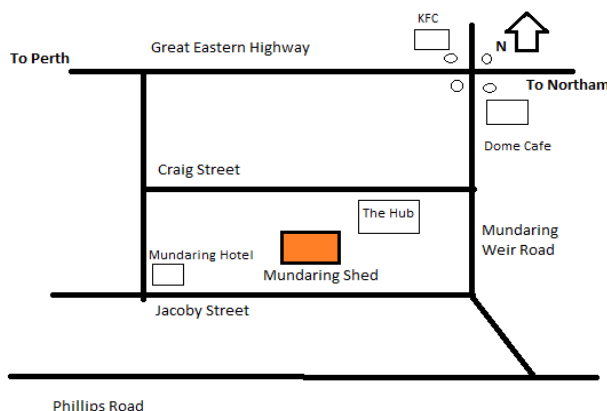

Established in 2007, the Mundaring Men's Shed (Inc) held its early meetings in the Hub of the Hills Community Centre in Mundaring.

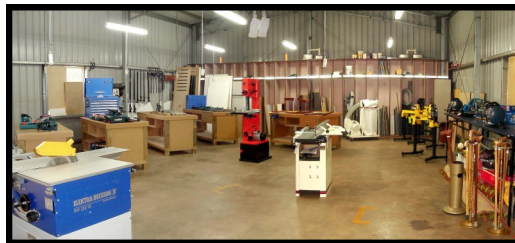


The Shire of Mundaring agrees to lease the old fire shed to MCMS November 2008

- Promote inter-generational, family and cultural interaction.*

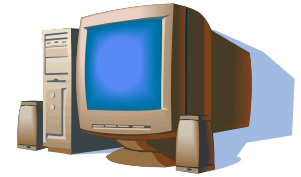
What can you do at the shed?
